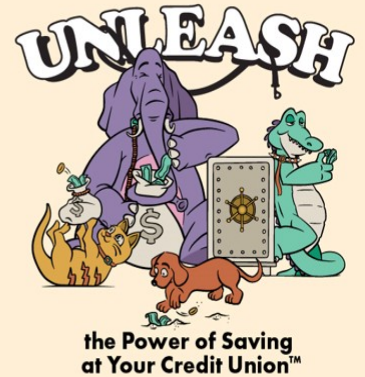

Credit Union deposits are safe

The collapse of *Silicon Valley Bank* a few weeks ago is the second largest failure of a financial institution in U.S. history. The bank was shut down and put under the control of the FDIC following a 48-hour bank run and capital crisis. On March 12, regulators also shut down *Signature Bank*. While this situation does not include any credit union failure, it may still create some fear to our members, but be reassured that FT Randall Federal Credit Union members and their deposits are safe and sound. Remember that Credit Unions are not for profit member-owned financial cooperatives. FT Randall FCU's capital is strong and financially stable.

- As a credit union member at FT Randall Federal Credit Union, you are an owner of our not-for-profit financial cooperative. Credit unions' first priority is your financial success, and we focus on financial security.

- Credit union members have never lost a penny of insured savings at a federally insured credit union.

New Options on Online Banking

Card-to-Account Transfer

This allows you to advance funds off a credit/debit card or gift card & deposit into your account.

Member-to-Member Transfer

This allows you to transfer funds from your account to another member of FRFCU by simply knowing their name and phone number.

Schedule Transfer

This allows you to schedule your own one time or recurring transfer to loan payments or accounts.

Make Loan Payment

This allows you to make a loan payment via credit/debit card or directly from account.

Card Freeze

This allows you to have access to turn on and off your debit card. Whether you're traveling or worried about an un-authorized transaction processing.
